## How Can Bible Texts Be Remembered?

\* "As you read the Bible, mark selected texts that you want to remember, or copy them on cards and put these cards where you will see them daily. As you try to memorize the verses, meditate on them and make use of them. Do not try to memorize too many at once, perhaps only one or two each week." (*Do You Remember - How can Bible texts be remembered - w95 8/15 p31*)  
*From suggestion (12) in Box on p16,17 w95 5/1*

\* Grouping a few Bible texts into subjects or categories makes it easier for our brain to remember. From the above list of scriptures (GEN to REV) you can select several verses that you like and group them into subjects or categories of your own.

"Categorize similar concepts or related ideas. ...Also, divide the information into manageable chunks of not more than five to seven items." (*g 2/09 p27*)

- **Helping Children Memorize Bible Verses**

Andrew's mother had helped him to memorize over 80 Bible verses word for word by the time he was six years of age.

"It wasn't a race," she says. "Our pace was very relaxed and natural. In fact, when someone finally asked, 'How many verses does he know?' I had to stop and add them up. Andrew enjoyed mastering new verses very much, and the list grew quickly."

But how did she do it? What books did she read first? Is there a trick to it?

- **Are You Strengthened by God's Word?**

WHEN faced with challenges, how do you cope? In Jesus' case, recalling an appropriate scripture helped him to face Satan's challenges. (Matthew 4:1-11) Likewise, when King David faced personal trials, he was strengthened by God's Word. He said: "When my disquieting thoughts became many inside of me, your own consolations began to fondle my soul." - Psalm 94:19.

In a similar manner, recalling a favorite scripture can console us or give us strength when we face challenges. For example, Rex, who is now 89 years of age, has been a full-time evangelizer since 1931. Yet, he says: "I often felt inadequate when given a special assignment in the ministry." How did he cope? "I recalled my favorite scripture, Proverbs 3:5, which says: 'Trust in Jehovah with all your heart and do not lean upon your own understanding.' Recalling and applying this scripture helped me to carry out my assignments successfully."

Even young ones benefit from having a favorite scripture. Six-year-old Jack says that his favorite scripture is Matthew 24:14. This scripture motivates him to go preaching with his parents. He says: "I like going witnessing every Saturday with my mum, dad, and sister."

Like Jesus, do you sometimes face direct challenges to your faith? Then Philippians 4:13 may become one of your favorite scriptures. Like King David, do you suffer from "disquieting thoughts"? Then recalling Philippians 4:6,7 may help you to cope.

Do you sometimes worry that your service to God is in vain? Then remembering 1 Corinthians 15:58 will give you strength.

By memorizing appropriate scriptures, we allow God's Word to exert power in our lives. (Hebrews 4:12) Such favorite scriptures can provide us with both strength and comfort. - Romans 15:4.

Do not hurry yourself in your spirit to become offended, for the taking of offense is what rests in the bosom of the stupid ones.

The conclusion of the matter, everything having been heard, is: Fear the true God and keep his commandments. For this is the whole obligation of man.

If, now, God thus clothes the vegetation of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much rather clothe YOU, YOU with little faith? So never be anxious and say, 'What are we to eat?' or, 'What are we to drink?' or, 'What are we to put on?' For all these are the things the nations are eagerly pursuing. For YOUR heavenly Father knows YOU need all these things.

**Matthew 6:33,34**

Keep on, then, seeking first the kingdom and his righteousness, and all these other things will be added to YOU. So, never be anxious about the next day, for the next day will have its own anxieties. Sufficient for each day is its own badness.

**Matthew 7:7-11**

Keep on asking, and it will be given YOU; keep on seeking, and YOU will find; keep on knocking, and it will be opened to YOU. For everyone asking receives, and everyone seeking finds, and to everyone knocking it will be opened. And do not become fearful of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; but rather be in fear of him that can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna.

**Matthew 10:29-31**

#### Luke 21:28

But as these things start to occur, raise yourselves erect and lift YOUR heads up, because YOUR deliverance is getting near.

#### Luke 21:34-36

But pay attention to yourselves that YOUR hearts never become weighed down with overeating and heavy drinking and anxieties of life, and suddenly that day be instantly upon YOU as a snare. For it will come in upon all those dwelling upon the face of all the earth. Keep awake, then, all the time making supplication that YOU may succeed in escaping all these things that are destined to occur, and in standing before the Son of man.

#### Romans 7:19-25

For all the things that were written aforetime were written for our instruction, that through our endurance and through the comfort from the Scriptures we might have hope.

Consequently, my beloved brothers, become steadfast, unmovable, always having plenty to do in the work of the Lord, knowing that YOUR labor is not in vain in connection with the Lord.

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of tender mercies and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those in any sort of tribulation through the comfort with which we ourselves are being comforted by God.

On the other hand, the fruitage of the spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faith, mildness, self-control.

Do not be misled: God is not one to be mocked. For whatever a man is sowing, this he will also reap.

#### Ephesians 4:26,27

Be wrathful, and yet do not sin; let the sun not set with YOU in a provoked state, neither allow place for the Devil.

Let a rotten saying not proceed out of YOUR mouth, but whatever saying is good for building up as the need may be, that it may impart what is favorable to the hearers.

Husbands, continue loving YOUR wives, just as the Christ also loved the congregation and delivered up himself for it,

#### Ephesians 6:11-18

Put on the complete suit of armor from God that YOU may be able to stand firm against the machinations of the Devil; because we have a wrestling, not against blood and flesh, but against the governments, against the authorities, against the world rulers of this darkness, against the wicked spirit forces in the heavenly places. On this account take up the complete suit of armor from God, that YOU may be able to resist in the wicked day and, after YOU have done all things thoroughly, to stand firm. Stand firm, therefore, with YOUR loins girded about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness, and with YOUR feet shod with the equipment of the good news of peace. Above all things, take up the large shield of faith, with which YOU will be able to quench all the wicked one's burning missiles. Also, accept the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the spirit, that is, God's word, while with every form of prayer and supplication YOU carry on prayer on every occasion in spirit.

#### **Philippians 4:6,7**

Do not be anxious over anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication along with thanksgiving let YOUR petitions be made known to God; and the peace of God that excels all thought will guard YOUR hearts and YOUR mental powers by means of Christ Jesus.

#### **Philippians 4:8,9**

Finally, brothers, whatever things are true, whatever things are of serious concern, whatever things are righteous, whatever things are chaste, whatever things are lovable, whatever things are well spoken of, whatever virtue there is and whatever praiseworthy thing there is, continue considering these things. The things that YOU learned as well as accepted and heard and saw in connection with me, practice these; and the God of peace will be with you.

Strip off the old personality with its practices, and clothe yourselves with the new personality, which through accurate knowledge is being made new according to the image of the One who created it,

Accordingly, as God's chosen ones, holy and loved, clothe yourselves with the tender affections of compassion, kindness, lowliness of mind, mildness, and long-suffering. Continue putting up with one another and forgiving one another freely if anyone has a cause for complaint against another. Even as Jehovah freely forgave YOU, so do YOU also. But, besides all these things, clothe yourselves with love, for it is a perfect bond of union.

#### **Colossians 3:15**

Also, let the peace of the Christ control in YOUR hearts,

according to the glorious good news of the happy God,

#### **1 Timothy 4:15,16**

Ponder over these things; be absorbed in them, that your advancement may be manifest to all persons. Pay constant attention to yourself and to your teaching. Stay by these things, for by doing this you will save both yourself and those who listen to you.

#### **2 Timothy 1:7**

For God gave us not a spirit of cowardice, but that of power and of love and of soundness of mind.

An unruly injurious thing, it is full of death-dealing poison. With it we bless Jehovah, even the Father, and yet with it we curse men who have come into existence "in the likeness of God." Out of the same mouth come forth blessing and cursing.

### James 3:17

But the wisdom from above is first of all chaste, then peaceable, reasonable, ready to obey, full of mercy and good fruits, not making partial distinctions, not hypocritical.

### 1 Peter 3:7

YOU husbands, continue dwelling in like manner with them according to knowledge, assigning them honor as to a weaker vessel, the feminine one, since YOU are also heirs with them of the undeserved favor of life, in order for YOUR prayers not to be hindered.

### 1 Peter 4:7,8

But the end of all things has drawn close. Be sound in mind, therefore, and be vigilant with a view to prayers. Above all things, have intense love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.

### 1 Peter 5:6,7

Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt YOU in due time; while YOU throw all YOUR anxiety upon him, because he cares for YOU.

But, after YOU have suffered a little while, the God of all undeserved kindness, who called YOU to his everlasting glory in union with Christ, will himself finish YOUR training, he will make YOU firm, he will make YOU strong.

### 2 Peter 1:5-8

Yes, for this very reason, by YOUR contributing in response all earnest effort, supply to YOUR faith virtue, to YOUR virtue knowledge, to YOUR knowledge self-control, to YOUR self-control endurance, to YOUR

endurance godly devotion, to YOUR godly devotion brotherly affection, to YOUR brotherly affection love. For if these things exist in YOU and overflow, they will prevent YOU from being either inactive or unfruitful regarding the accurate knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

#### 1 John 2:15-17

Do not be loving either the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him; because everything in the world - the desire of the flesh and the desire of the eyes and the showy display of one's means of life - does not originate with the Father, but originates with the world. Furthermore, the world is passing away and so is its desire, but he that does the will of God remains forever.

#### 1 John 4:8

He that does not love has not come to know God, because God is love.

#### 1 John 4:18

There is no fear in love, but perfect love throws fear outside, because fear exercises a restraint. Indeed, he that is under fear has not been made perfect in love.

#### 1 John 4:20

If anyone makes the statement: "I love God," and yet is hating his brother, he is a liar. For he who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot be loving God, whom he has not seen.

#### Revelation 4:11

You are worthy, Jehovah, even our God, to receive the glory and the honor and the power, because you created all things, and because of your will they existed and were created.
